Reading in FS1

The children have now settled into our school and are bringing home a reading book and a library book. The reading book is a discussion book, this will contain no words. Please discuss the pictures and ask them lots of guestions about what is happening in the book. The library book may be a story or information book and will probably contain words, it would be great if you could share the book with your

child and read to them on a regular basis. 10 minutes sharing books daily will have a huge impact on your child's love of reading and future learning. I am sure you will support us in this. Books will be changed on a Friday.

Home/school learning journey book

We will be sending home a home/school learning journey book each week. This book will have challenges for your child to complete over the half term. The book is a journal of your child's learning outside of school and we look forward to sharing experiences through the journal. These will be given out on Fridays

and to be returned to school by Monday.

Each Thursday every child who wants to will be given the opportunity to join in our exciting 'Forest Schools' activity sessions. Please make sure that your child has wellies in school every Thursday so that they can take part. We will be completing activities such as den building, nature watching, digging and mud-pie making.

Nursery will have their PE hall slot on a Wednesday morning each week. Please ensure your child has suitable kit in school at all times though. Earrings must be removed for your child to take part in PE sessions; if your child cannot remove their own earrings school staff cannot do it for them. We would advise no jewellery to be worn to school on any day.

This half term in our PE lessons we will be learning lots of different ways of moving and continuing to develop throwing, catching, hitting and kicking skills.
