The year 4 team have organised an exciting residential visit to How Hill. How Hill is a large, thatched house near Ludham, that overlooks beautiful gardens, wetlands and the river Ant in Norfolk.

We are planning to take two groups of children; the first will stay from Monday 6th July until Wednesday 8th July and the second from Wednesday 8th July until Friday 10th July. The cost of the trip will be £150.00, which includes accommodation, transport, three meals a day, snacks and a variety of craft and outdoor activities.

The pupils will participate in a variety of environmental activities such as dyke dipping, a boat trip to Barton Broad, thatching and nature walks. Craft activities include clay work and environmental art. It is an ideal opportunity for those children who have never been away from home before to experience this in a secure environment.
